## SIGMUND FREUD

Sigmund Freud, the founder of psychoanalysis, was originally a neuroscientist. At the turn of the last century the basic research was not noticeably subsidized. In order to obtain means for his living he devoted efforts to his neurological practice, later also purely to the psychological treatment and to the research dealing with disorders of mental functions. However, even as a renowned psychoanalyst, he had never failed to believe that "one day", with the coming advances in research of psychoanalysis and neuroscience, both streams of the research of psyche would complement each other in a useful manner.
